Also included are price ranges and average prices for each arrangement to help you get an idea of what your budget might be. Bride's Bouquet

One of the most important elements of the bride's attire is the bridal bouquet. Preferred styles, colors, scents, sizes and shapes vary from one bride to another. We are here to help you choose which is best suited for your wedding, whether it be an all-white bouquet or an eye-catching colorful bouquet. A bride's bouquet ranges from \$95 to \$500. Avg.\$225-\$275

You wouldn't want to mess up your stunning bouquet during the bride's toss would you? We can create a smaller, just as beautiful bouquet specifically for tossing, that way you can still hang on to that bouquet of yours! Bride's toss bouquets average at about \$55.

Bridesmaid's Bouquet

Bridesmaid's bouquets typically compliment the bride's bouquet and are smaller in size. The bridesmaid's bouquets should coordinate with the overall style of the wedding. They are usually identical, but you might want to consider choosing different flowers, colors and styles for each of your bridesmaids depending on their dress, to play it up a bit! With that being said, some brides choose to make the maid of honor's bouquet different in size and color to differ from the other bridesmaids. Bridesmaid's bouquets range from \$55 to \$155. Avg.\$95

Corsages (Mothers, Grandmothers, etc.)

Corsages do not have to be exactly the same, but they should coordinate with the dresses and the overall style of the wedding. Corsages can be pin, magnets or wrist corsages. Some great choices for corsages are gardenias, orchids and roses due to their wide range of color availability. The average price for a corsage is about \$35.



Boutonnieres (Groom, Groomsmen, Fathers, Grandfathers, etc.)

Boutonnieres are typically fairly small with just a few blossoms. Some popular boutonniere blooms are orchid, stephanotis or freesia. The average price is about \$20.

The Ceremony

Flowers at the main altar are there not only to look beautiful but to direct the guests' attention to the front of the ceremony space. Since no ceremony is just alike, these arrangements can be as elaborate or simple as your style dictates. The price ranges for these arrangements are about \$125 to \$750 each. Avg. \$155-\$250. However, you may also be interested in a free standing arch with seasonal flowers or a chuppah to be at the main altar. The free standing arches typically range from \$450 to \$1000 and the chuppah from \$500 to \$2500.

Brides typically want to add more to their ceremony, aisle pew markers are a great way to add a little color to the ceremony. Flowers, candles, ribbon and a small cluster of flowers are all great ways to add some color. Prices for pew markers range from \$10 to \$50 each. Avg. \$30

The Reception

The flowers for your reception should be a reflection of your style and overall color scheme. Not only do flowers add beauty, fragrance and color to your reception space, but they can transform any room into a warm, inviting space. Table centerpieces should complement the flowers in the reception space. Keep in mind that although a big beautiful centerpiece would be amazing, centerpieces need to be low enough so that your guests can easily converse with each other. Prices for centerpieces range from \$50 to \$300. Avg \$105-\$135

If you decide to use buffet or cocktail tables, floral arrangements will add some extra color to the food display. If you are using a buffet table, you might want to consider multiple arrangements across the table. Likewise for cocktail tables, they can be decorated with smaller arrangements corresponding with the arrangements on the buffet tables and centerpieces. Buffet table arrangements vary from \$175 to \$750. Avg. \$400 and cocktail table arrangements range from \$15 to \$50. Avg. \$35

Also, fresh flowers are a beautiful addition to a wedding cake. We can work your flower scheme into cake decorations. These flowers range from \$40 to \$200. Avg. \$65

A 30% labor fee is attached to all wedding floral packages. This labor fee covers the following: consultation time with wedding designer, wedding floral proposal and revisions thereafter, any site visits with your designer, locating, ordering and processing of flowers, boxing, delivering, ceremony and reception set-up, breakdown and pick-up any rental items.

Unfortunately we are unable to “temporarily hold” dates. If you would like to reserve our services we require 20% of your proposal estimate or \$300 non-refundable deposit, whichever is greater. This deposit is credited toward your balance and will allow you to make any necessary changes to the proposal. There is an additional 50% balance due 90 days prior to the event, which also becomes non-refundable at that time. The balance is due 21 days prior to the event at which point we will place your floral order with our growers.
